Public Works Committee Meeting Minutes

September 8, 2022

1. **Call to Order** – The Public Works Committee Meeting was called to order by A. Docksey at 9:00 AM.
2. **Public Comment** – D. Bertelsen and C. Tyllo expressed their concerns with only the perimeter being cut on the large vacant lot at the rear of their properties.
3. **Adoption of Public Works Committee August 11, 2022 Meeting Minutes** – J. Schneider motioned to approve the August 11, 2022 meeting minutes as presented, F. Risler seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
4. **Discussion of Weed and Grass Control Requirements – Sec. 38-36 of the Village Code of Ordinances** – Staff would like to update the ordinance referring to the noxious weed and grass control. For lots sizes that exceed one acre in a platted developed subdivision, only a 30ft wide buffer will be mowed. The Committee had concerns with language and would like “surface land disturbance activities” used instead of the developed subdivision definition of Village-accepted roadways and utilities available to support residential lot development. F. Risler motioned to recommend that the Village Board approve Sec. 38-36 of the Village Code of Ordinances as presented with discussed changes, J. Schneider seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
5. **Joint Road Projects with the City of Racine – Municipal Agreements** – The City of Racine reached out to the Village regarding two sections of Eaton Ln. and Winthrop Ave. where the municipal boundaries split the lots in half. The Committee would like clarity on some of the language in the agreements and Staff would like the actual numbers for the projects from the City.
6. **Committee and Staff Reports**
  - **Director of Public Works** - None
  - **Deputy Director of Public Works** - **2022 Paving Program** – The paving program is almost entirely complete with the exception of 90<sup>th</sup> St. There are also sidewalks in the Village that are currently under construction and the addition to Christina Estates has not started.
    - **90<sup>th</sup> St. Resurfacing** – The paving is scheduled to be completed next week.
  - **Public Works Superintendent** - **Chicory Road Signage Update** – New signage has been installed in the area to help eliminate truck traffic.
7. **Adjourn** – J. Schneider motioned to adjourn the Public Works Committee Meeting at 9:24 AM, F. Risler seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
