

**RESOLUTION 16-2025  
RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING USE OF  
OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS TO PURCHASE A TRUNARC DELTA HANDHELD  
ANALYZER AND TYPE H2 KIT**

**September 22, 2025**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Mount Pleasant is a recipient of Opioid Settlement Funds, a nationwide legal settlement with pharmaceutical companies and distributors;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Mount Pleasant Police Department regularly investigates opioid related narcotics violations and overdoses, placing officers in contact with opioids that require handling and testing;

**WHEREAS**, the TruNarc Delta Handheld Analyzer is a device that uses a non-contact technique called Raman Spectroscopy to test and identify narcotics and other substances using a low powered laser. This device reduces officer exposure risk to opioids, including accidental overdose and assists in rapidly identifying suspected drug types and other substances at overdose scenes, allowing for faster, more accurate treatment.


**NOW THEREFORE**, the Village Board of the Village of Mount Pleasant, Racine County, Wisconsin does hereby resolve:

- To amend the 2025 budget by increasing Opioid Settlement Expense Account # 290-000-67100 by \$36,460.00 for the purchase of the TruNarc Delta Handheld Analyzer.
- The Opioid Settlement Fund has sufficient balance to fund this increase in expenditure
