

2025 REAL ESTATE TAX INFORMATION

DUE DATES

Full payment or the 1st installment must be paid by January 31, 2026, to avoid penalties. After January 31, payments are only accepted at the Racine County Treasurer's office.

Payments must be postmarked by December 31, 2025, to be applied as a 2025 payment.

Please Note: A payment must be mailed at least one day before a deadline date to ensure it is postmarked by that deadline.

RECEIPTS

For a receipt, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your payment. Scan the QR code to view or print your receipt online.



REFUNDS

If your escrow check exceeds the amount due, a refund will be issued six to eight weeks after the payment clears all banks. Residents may check the status of their refund by contacting the Village Treasurer.

RETURNED PAYMENTS

Any payment, including online or mailed payments, that is cancelled or returned by your bank will be assessed a \$25.00 return fee.

WHAT IS THE RECYCLING FEE ON MY TAX BILL?

The Recycling Fee (\$46.00) represents the amount per household that the Village is charged for annual recycling collection services. Only households that use the service will pay the fee through tax collections.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Per Wisconsin State Statute §74.09, Real Estate Property Tax Bills are mailed to the owner on record. Failure to pay property taxes on time may result in late fees and penalties. Questions regarding Property Tax Bills and payments should be directed to the Village Treasurer.

ONLINE

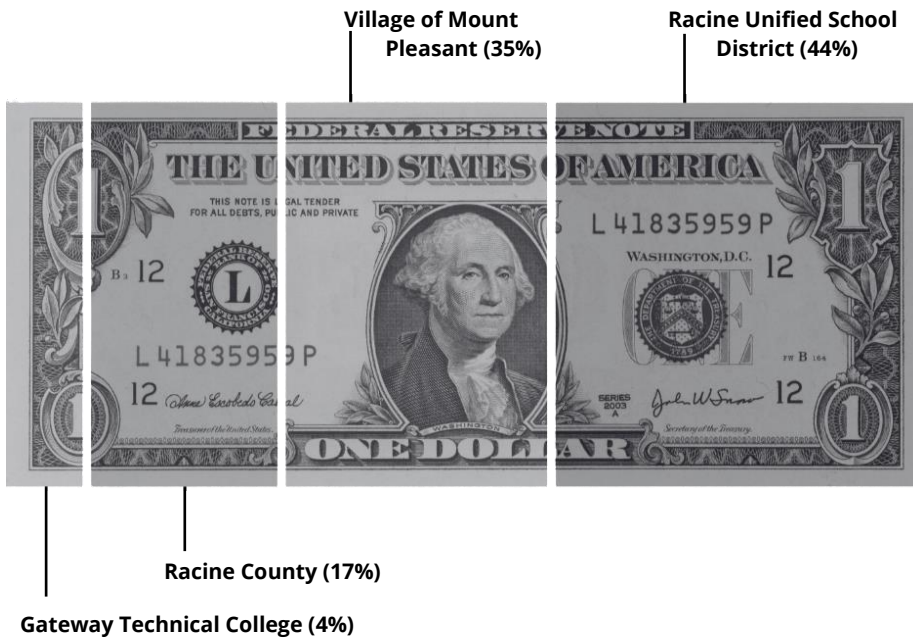
Pay online with an E-check or a credit card. Service charges for online payments are as follows:

E-check: \$1.50/each
Credit card: 2.50% of the payment amount



Include the following with your payment:

- ✓ Parcel number or bill number on the check
- ✓ Phone number on the check for questions
- ✓ Payment coupon provided with tax bill
- ✓ Endorse all escrow checks. If there are multiple names, all parties must sign the check
- ✓ Do not combine other payments with your tax payment (pet license, sewer payment, etc.)



WHERE EACH TAX DOLLAR GOES...

Mount Pleasant collects your property tax bill on behalf of all local taxing jurisdictions. Mount Pleasant government controls only the Village portion, and other taxing jurisdictions set their net tax amounts.

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL

Pursuant to Municipal Code §70-6, all sidewalks shall be kept reasonably free and clear of snow and ice. After and during every snowfall, property owners must clear snow from sidewalks before 10:00 a.m. of each day. Snow and Ice are not to be placed on any street, alley, highway, road, sidewalk, crosswalk, public right-of-way, or public ground.

SNOW EMERGENCIES

If a snow emergency is declared in the Village, parking restrictions go into effect until the emergency expires or is cancelled. Snow emergencies are posted on the Village website and social media accounts.

CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

Curbside Christmas Tree collection runs from January 7 to January 20. Trees are picked up on your regularly scheduled collection day and must be decoration-free. Place trees at the curb line, not on the road. Wreaths can be placed in trash bins. Dates may be altered due to inclement weather.

E-CYCLE DAY

The annual electronics collection day will take place on September 26, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Mount Pleasant Village Hall.

COMPOST SITE

The Compost Site is located at the end of West Road, north of Washington Avenue. Dates and hours of operation for 2026 are April 1 to November 18.
